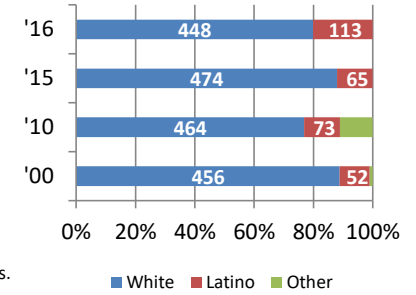

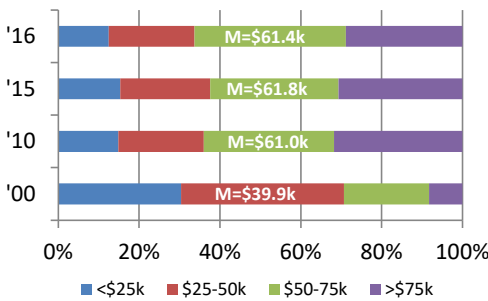


Race/Ethnicity

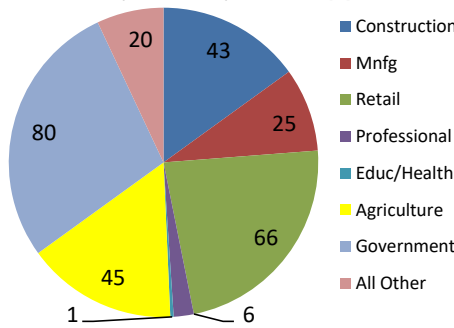

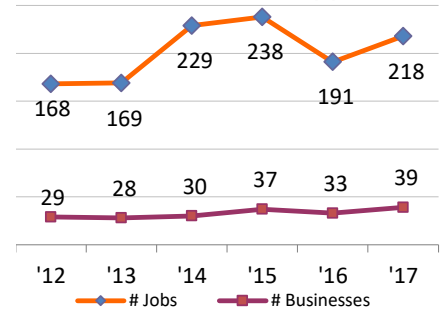
Household Income Distribution*

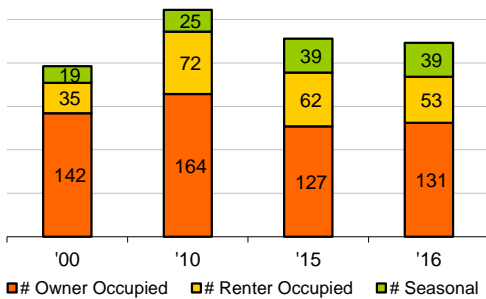

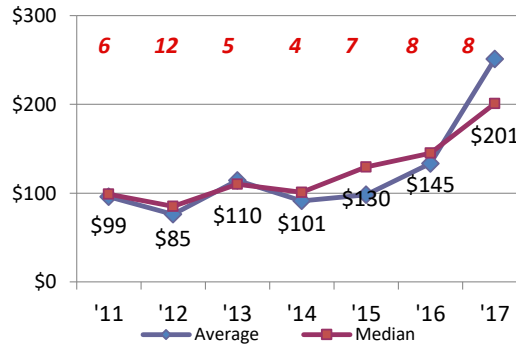

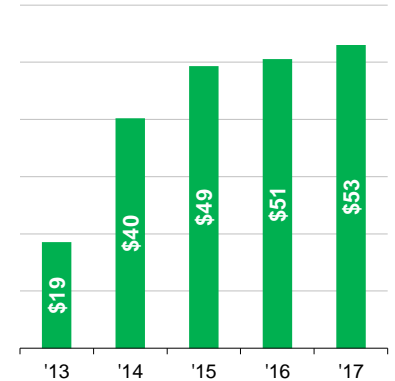
Housing Stock Utilization(# units)

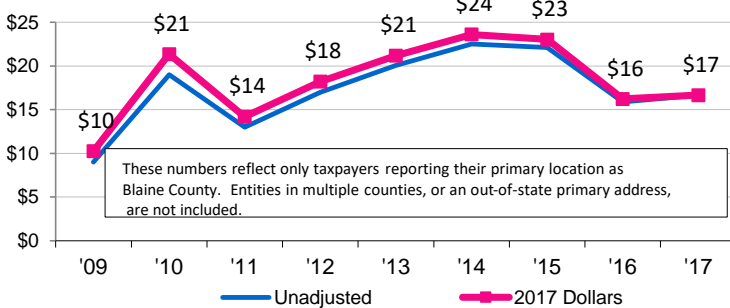

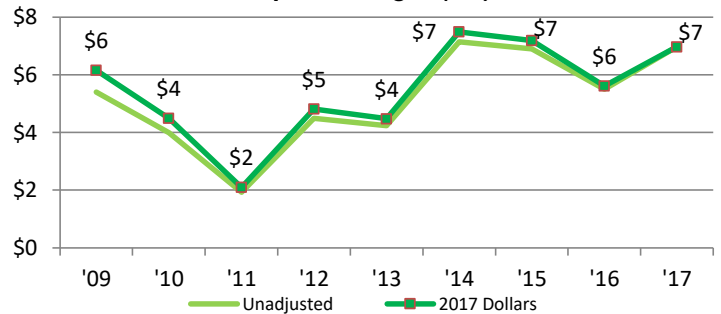

Reported Sales (\$m)

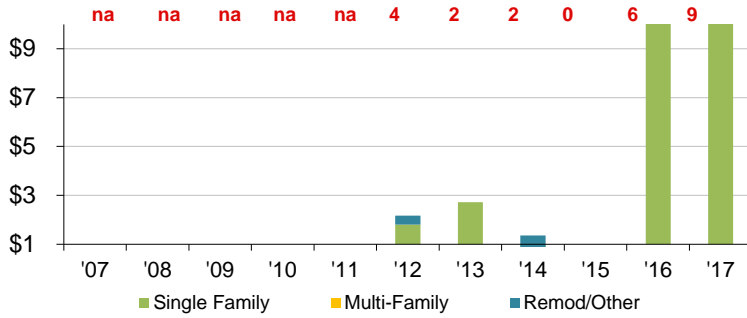


Reported Wages (\$m)

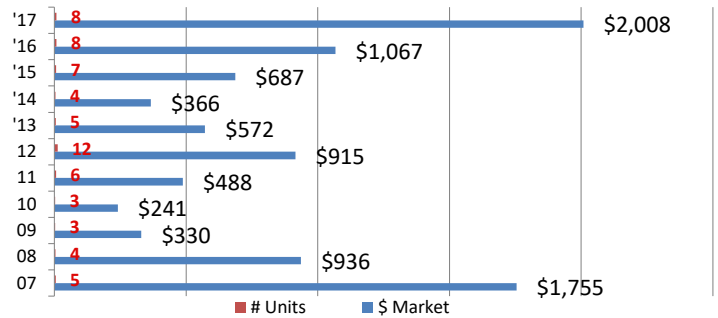

Residential Building Permits (\$000 & #)

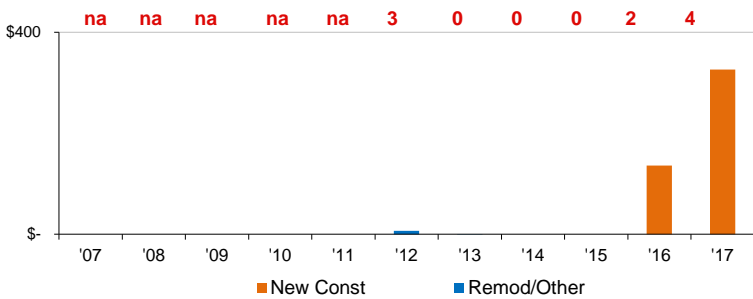


Residential Sales Transactions (\$000 & #)

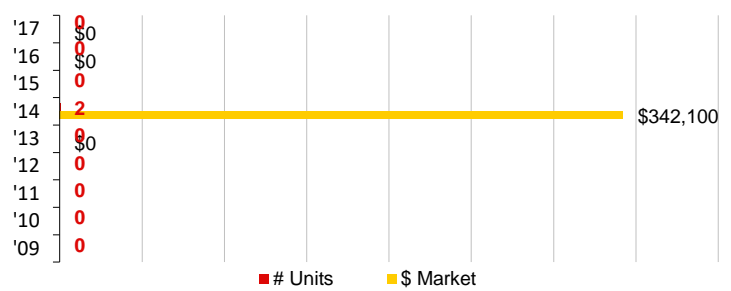

Commercial Building Permits (\$000 & #)

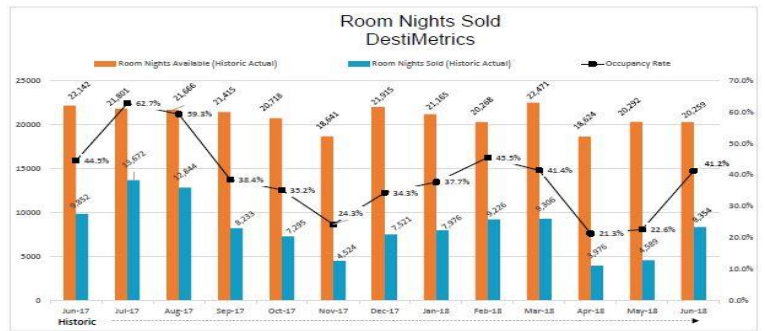
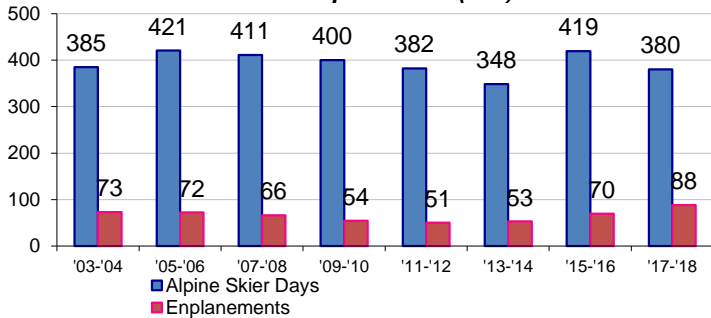


Commercial Sales Transactions (\$000 & #)

Skier & Airport Visits (000)

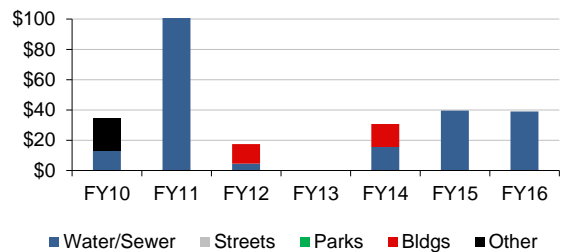
